

SALVAGE UPPER LIMB IN NECROTIZING FASCIITIS

60yrs old female H/o Right upper limb cellulitis with skin necrosis taking treatment outside. She came to VishwaRaj Hospital with large necrotic ulcer over right arm and forearm.

Debridement was done under General Anaesthesia. Treated with antibiotics and analgesic. Aggressive post operative management done which includes dressing and SSI (Surgical Site Infection Monitoring).

Discharged on POD 4 with total recovery and healthy granulation tissue on ulcer.

Skin grafting of the large wound was done with 100% graft take up in second set. Patient came for follow up after 10 days but the excitement and joy that she expressed towards the hospital and treating consultant was outstanding and shown healthy graft.
